Figure 2.6 Location of Public Sector Treatment for SWSAHS Residents 2002/3: TRACHEOSTOMY (Seps)\*

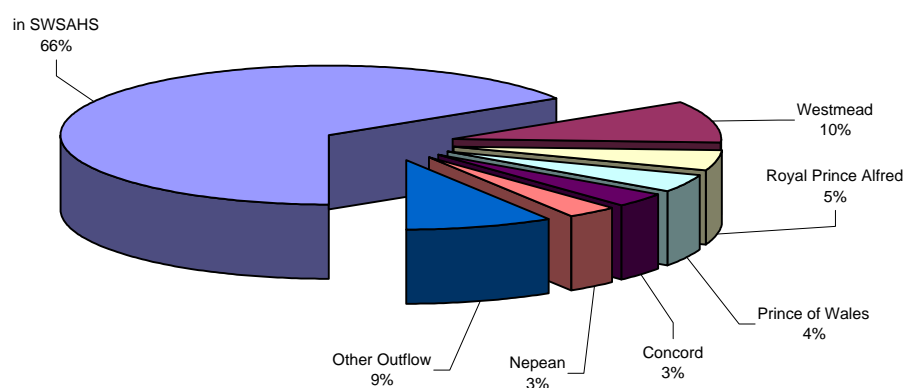
