Figure 23.3 Location of Public Sector Treatment for SWSAHS Residents 2002/3: NEUROLOGY (Seps)\*

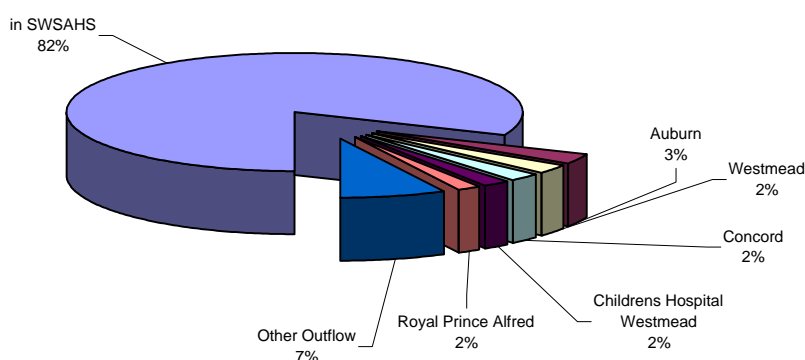
