COURSE OUTLINE

The Definitive Surgical Trauma Course (DSTC) is an invigorating, exciting opportunity to focus on surgical decision-making and surgical operative technique in critically ill trauma patients. The two-day course will provide you with an opportunity of working with experts in the field, including an International Faculty of leaders in trauma care. You will have hands on practical experience with experienced instructors working in an animal laboratory setting, as well as on human cadavers at Royal Melbourne & Liverpool Hospitals. This unique surgical operative laboratory will give you insight into difficult trauma situations with vascular isolation and ability to handle major thoracic, cardiac and abdominal injuries. Small surgical teams of four will operate under the guidance of a national and international Faculty. The DSTC course has been widely acclaimed and eight courses have been undertaken so far in Australia. The course is recommended by the RACS for all surgeons involved in the management of major trauma.

MILITARY MODULE

The Military Module was introduced in 2000 as an optional third day for ADF and other interested personnel, which can only be undertaken when the DSTC course has also been completed. This year it will be held in Sydney.
