- Bright, fresh and uplifting colours to provide a warm and friendly environment
- New high quality lighting
- Four interview/consultation rooms
- One dedicated eye/ear nose and throat room
- Three procedure rooms
- A plaster room
- Two treatment rooms
- Two safe observation rooms
- Covered ambulance entrance bay
