### **Campbelltown Hospital suspends nurses**

Two nurses have been suspended following an alleged assault of a patient.

Acting general manager of Campbelltown Hospital JoAnne Fisher said the nurses had been suspended immediately.

“This type of behaviour is totally unacceptable,” she said.

“We made immediate contact with the next of kin and have apologised for the incident,” she said.

We are in regular contact with the family and will inform them of the outcome of our investigation and any further disciplinary action.
