Bankstown Hospital has reassured the mother of a baby given the wrong breast milk that her child's health was not at risk.

Tests were done for infections as soon as the incident was discovered.

Bankstown Hospital executive director Andrew Bernard said they had kept Mrs Guevarra informed and updated while waiting for test results.

"Mrs Guevarra has been fully informed of the result and has been given a letter confirming the tests were negative," he said.
