Death of Dr Elizabeth KERNOHAN BScAgr, MScAgr, PhD **1939-2004**

Campbelltown Hospital has been asked to release the following statement on behalf of the family and friends of the late Dr Elizabeth KERNOHAN.

Dr Kernohan was brought into the Emergency Department of Campbelltown Hospital by ambulance early this morning after becoming suddenly ill at home.

In the Emergency Department, she was attended by senior medical and nursing staff for several hours, including a cardiologist, but suffered a sudden deterioration and despite all efforts to resuscitate her, was pronounced dead shortly after midday.

Dr Kernohan's death was sudden and unexpected and her family and friends request privacy at this time.

The staff of Camden and Campbelltown hospitals are saddened by the sudden passing of Dr Kernohan who was a long standing friend and supporter of the two hospitals.
